Mother's Day is Sunday May 8. While commonly regarded as just another Hallmark Holiday, the actual celebration of Mother's Day is steeped in history. The acknowledgment of a day dedicated to mothers is generally attributed to Julia Ward Howe – an abolitionist best remembered as the poet who wrote "Battle Hymn of the Republic", who made a public proclamation in 1870, just five years after the Civil War, exhorting all women to dedicate themselves to peace: "Arise, all women who have hearts". Julia Ward Howe's message to mothers is as true now as it was 150 years ago, "Our sons shall not be taken from us to unlearn all that we have been able to teach them of charity, mercy and patience. We women of one country will be too tender of those of another country to allow our sons to be trained to injure theirs." I rather like the idea that our "public expression of love and reverence" for the mothers in our lives should be regarded with the sentiments of "charity, mercy and patience".




