## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

#### Benvenuti a tutti!

As I mentioned during the July Dinner Dance: The splendor of the Verdi Club did not spontaneously combust. Verdi Club members and staff work to create the pleasant and welcoming experience we all enjoy at the Verdi Club. The greater the number of people participating, the lighter the load for each. There are a variety of ways to serve for the Verdi Club, and many opportunities that will fit with your work or social schedule. Please contact any of the Officers or Board Members to learn more.

Last month I announced that we will hold Member meetings and elections for Officers and Board Members in the fall. This month I am including a description of each position and their duties (which I have shamelessly cribbed from Delores' descriptions from last year's newsletter).

Anyone who is a Vested Member in good standing for at least the last 12 months is eligible for a Board or Officer position. Every member in good standing is invited to serve on a Committee. Currently, the Verdi Club has the following Committees that could use your help: Entertainment, Membership and Finance.

Officers and Board Members are expected to attend the monthly Board Meetings where decisions about major undertakings and expenditures related to the Verdi Club are made. Board Members are also expected to actively participate in running Verdi Club Member activities.

**President** – The President is the Chief Executive of the Verdi Club, and she/he presides over all meetings and enforces all provisions, objects and purposes of the Club.

**Vice-President** – In the absence of the President, the Vice President performs the duties of that office and other duties as may be required of her/him.

**Treasurer** – The Treasurer deposits all money and other valuables in the name of the Verdi Club. She/he oversees payment of all bills received.

**Financial Secretary** – The Financial Secretary keeps and maintains written accounts of the properties and business transactions of the Verdi Club, including accounts of its assets and liabilities, receipts, disbursements, gains, losses, capital, dues, assessments and supplies.

**Recording Secretary** – The Recording Secretary records the minutes of all meetings and makes sure that the books, reports, documents, and communications required by law are properly kept and filed.

**Sergeant of Arms** – The Sergeant of Arms ensures that order is maintained in and out of the meeting room during meetings.

**Executive Board** – Oversees all major undertakings or expenditures required for the ongoing maintenance and expansion of the Verdi Club. There are five Board Members and an additional, alternate Board Member (for a total of 6 Board Members).

The A.R.K.'s high-energy jazzy vibe has whisked them all over the globe, from the Greystone Mansion in Beverly Hills, to performances in Hungary, Austria, Germany, and back to the USA to play at the 60th Grammy Awards Nominee San Francisco Chapter Celebration.

You may also catch the band entertaining at top jazz clubs (Herb Alpert's Vibrato Grill), exclusive private spots (the French Club, University Club of San Francisco), swanky casinos (the Peppermill in Reno, Nevada, Agua Caliente in Palm Springs, the Orleans in Las Vegas), top class hotels (the Hay-Adams in Washington, D.C.), or family-friendly theme parks (Disneyland Resort, California's Great America).




### Sylvia M. Hidalgo May 1st, 1947 – June 8th, 2022
