#### **Gino Joseph Pettinari**


February 24, 1927 - September 4, 2022

Our beloved Gino Pettinari passed away on September 4th, 2022. Our members have cherished memories of Gino's enduring presence at our Club from overseeing our 7:00 am set up for our monthly dinner dances, his attendance in his dapper attire, and the endless menagerie of animals he created out of wood for our monthly raffles. He served as a board of director for many years. In celebration of Gino he was bestowed the honor of Outstanding Verdi Club Member.

Gino Pettinari was born on February 24, 1927, to Pacifico and Gina Pettinari in North Beach, San Francisco, at home and across the street from the San Remo Restaurant.

Gino has one sister, Nadia Sutherland. Nadia and Gino lost their mother two weeks after Gino was born and he was raised by his sister and friends.

Gino's family later moved to Stockton so their father could work on farms to support the family. Shortly after, the family moved back to San Francisco where their father got a job with Michel & Pfeffer (an iron works company) in San Bruno.



When he came home from the Army, he was asked what he wanted. He said a

convertible and a blonde. He met the woman of his dreams, Jaquelyn "Jackie" Taylor, in 1947. They married in 1950 at Star of the Sea Church in San Francisco. Yes, he also got his convertible. They had two sons, Michael Gene and Patrick Edward.

His family grew to 6 Grandchildren and 10 Great-grandchildren. He also had what he liked to call his "extra" children – many daughters, sons, and grandchildren – "extra to spoil".

He loved all his family and friends.

Gino worked at Standard Oil, was a journeyman roofer for 18 years and worked for Millbrae Lumber Company for 22 years as a Teamster Truck Driver.

In retirement, Gino swam a mile every weekday morning at Orange Park Pool. He also bowled twice a week. Woodworking was his passion, so every chance he had he made plant holders, baby cradles, rocking horses, birdhouses, and many other projects.

He served as the Retired Teamsters Club Vice President of Local #2785. He was an active member of the SSF Elks Lodge #2091.

He was the embodiment of goodness. He was a generous kind man and all of us who were fortunate to know him loved him.
