NOTES FROM YOUR VERDI CLUB BOARD

Wishing Associate Member Marco Bass Well in His Mission

On February 24th, 2022 Russia invaded the sovereign nation of Ukraine. The entire world (with notable exceptions) gasped in the unfolding horror – a country besieged by violence, war crimes and the kidnapping of Ukrainian children. For one San Franciscan, Verdi Club Member Marco Bass, this act of war struck a nerve; it began a calling he could not ignore. On the heels of his 70th birthday he made the commitment to travel to the war-torn country, following his heart.

Marco Bass had spent years teaching kindergarten through 8th grade in Catholic and public schools in Columbus, Ohio. He knew he must answer the call and reach out to the vulnerable children of Ukraine. In October 2022 he began his research, first at the Most Holy Redeemer Catholic Church in the Castro neighborhood and later, at a fundraiser which began his relationship with the Ukrainian Catholic University in Lviv, Ukraine. A professor at the Chicago Ukrainian Catholic University knew Marco's teaching experience would prove valuable. Marco was gratefully accepted as a volunteer for the English Summer School Program, teaching English Immersion.

Since relocating to San Francisco Marco has been a substitute teacher at St. James, St. John and St. Phillip's Schools. Marco plays a large role in the lives of his daughter Samantha and granddaughters Margaret and Bernadette, who reside in Eureka Valley. He has been an active member of our Verdi Club family. During our in-service day he worked at painting the upstairs green room, along with Caroline Anzur, another Verdi Club Member, who has become his life partner. Caroline captained much of the complicated travel arrangements for the Ukraine trip.

Marco's arduous journey began with a flight to Los Angeles. His overnight flight to Warsaw, Poland was followed by a 10-hour bus ride. His paperwork was in order, but traveling across the border into Ukraine is not for the faint of heart, as there are no direct flights into the country. Marco will return to San Francisco on August 10th following 9 weeks of teaching and all types of humanitarian work. One of his goals is to help create a Sister Catholic Church with our beloved Most Holy Redeemer.

Living on the University campus Marco will become part of the community which has come together in support of volunteers like Marco who have traveled from around the globe to do what they can. This famous quote of former President Jimmy Carter has particular resonance for Marco: "My Faith demands - this is not optional - my Faith demands that I do whatever I can, wherever I can, for as long as I can with whatever I have to try to make a difference."


