



Jack Palomino Hidalgo

June 9, 1936 - July 11, 2023

Our hearts are heavy with news of Jack Hidalgo's passing. He was a long time Verdi member, Board member and President. Jack passed away peacefully at the San Francisco VA on July 21st of 2023, at the age of 87.

September 21, 1938 - July 10, 2023




